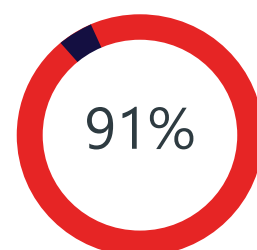

## 3 Apprenticeship program

The apprentice completes **three training periods** of 2000 hours each, all close to a year full-time, for a total of approximately three years.

*\*Hourly rates represent the light residential sector, it may increase bases on the sector of activity.*

- B** APPRENTICE LEVEL 2 *from 26\$/Hour\**
- C** APPRENTICE LEVEL 3 *from 31\$/Hour\**

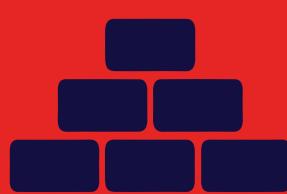
